

PLEASE CAREFULLY READ THE FOLLOWING SAFETY RULES BEFORE USING YOUR RIFLE.

Rifles can be dangerous if not used properly and can cause serious injury and death. The following safety and security rules describe user responsibilities related to the rifle.

- a) Never send your rifle (loaded or unloaded) to a person. Do not straighten gun to anyone.
- b) Do not aim your rifle towards an unsafe place for shooting. Never shoot on hard surfaces or water.
- c) Keep the safety of your gun open (the red warning line should be invisible) until you are ready to shoot.
- d) Keep your finger away from the trigger until you decide to shoot.
- e) Make sure that the inside of the barrel is clean.
- f) Learn the working system and safety features of your gun well. Please note, however, that no safety mechanism can be used to ensure that safe use procedures does not take its place.
- g) Keep your gun out of reach of children.
- h) Do not delay the maintenance of your gun.
- i) Use suitable cartridges in your gun and avoid the use of hand-loaded cartridges.
- j) Always use safety glasses and earplugs while shooting.
- k) Do not use alcoholic beverages, drugs or drugs that may cause distraction before or during use of your weapon.
- I) Do not leave cartridges when you are not using your gun.
- m) Do not make any mechanical changes to your gun.
- n) Have your gun repaired only at authorized services.

WARNING: Each rifle has the potential to kill you or another person.

Accidents occur as a result of non-compliance with safety rules and carelessness.

WARNING: Unloading, cleaning, or servicing your rifle in a poorly ventilated environment; may cause you to inhale burnt gases.

These gases can cause birth defects, permanent damage, and other serious injury. Always maintain your rifle in well-ventilated environments. Wash your hands after care.



1) NEVER MAKE CHANGES OR MODIFICATIONS ON THE RIFLE.

This shotgun has been manufactured under specific manufacturer's instructions and under ANY circumstances modifications or modifications to the shotgun should not be made. Replacing the trigger, mechanical parts and safety systems, or using products other than those delivered in the original box of the rifle; It is NOT RECOMMENDED by the manufacturer as it may endanger the safety of both you and the people around you and cause death and injury. Any replacement on the shotgun WILL ALSO VOID THE FACTORY WARRANTY.

2) PROPER MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE.

Regular maintenance and cleaning is essential to keeping your shotgun's effectiveness, functionality and durability at its highest level. ALWAYS make sure your rifle is unloaded before you start cleaning your rifle.

- 3) MAKE SURE YOU HAVE FULLY READ AND UNDERSTAND THE USER'S MANUAL BEFORE USING YOUR FIRE WEAPON.
- 4) ALWAYS BE AWARE OF THE OPERATION AND USE CHARACTERISTICS SPECIFIC TO YOUR RIFLE.
- 5) KEEP YOUR RIFLE UNLOADED (WITHOUT A CARTRIDGE) UNTIL IT IS READY TO USE.

When you have your rifle in your hand, turn the rifle's safety button to the off position (pointing to the white dot), remove the magazine, and check the chamber to make sure it is empty 1) After firing 2) Before putting the rifle aside 3) Before putting the rifle in its holster 4) When you are not using the rifle 5) Remove all cartridges from the magazine and chamber before handing over the rifle to someone else.

NFVFR:

- Do not leave a loaded rifle unattended.
- Do not assume that the same rifle is unloaded, even if it was the last time you used the rifle.

Always make sure that there is no cartridge in the rifle and that the chamber .make sure it is empty.

- Do not insert the cartridge into the chamber until you are ready to fire.
- You must not carry or take the rifle with a real (loaded) cartridge in the chamber.



6- KEEP YOUR FINGER AWAY FROM THE TRIGGER UNTIL YOU ARE READY TO FIRE!

- 7- ALWAYS KEEP YOUR RIFLE AIMED IN A SAFE DIRECTION: A safe direction is one in which you or someone else will not be injured or harmed if the rifle fires unintentionally.
- 8- ALWAYS USE SUITABLE ROUNDS: All firearms are designed to use ammunition of a certain caliber. Only use ammunition recommended by the manufacturer. HUNT GROUP MX4 semi-automatic shotguns are 12 and 76 mm magnum, chambered. Our 12 Caliber rifles are 70 mm. (28 gr.) to 76 mm. (52 gr.) It is designed to be used with all factory full cartridges. WARNING: Never use a single bullet with 1, 2 and 3 shocks.

WARNING. Never use a single bullet with 1, 2 and 5 shocks.


WARNING: Never use steel shot cartridges with 1 and 2 chokes.

- 9- COMPLY WITH THE LAWS REGARDING THE PURCHASE, OWNERSHIP, HANDLING AND USE OF FIRE ARMS.
- 10- ALWAYS BE AWARE OF YOUR TARGET AND WHAT IS BEHIND THE TARGET!
 11- ALWAYS WEAR MATERIALS TO PROTECT YOUR EYES, EARS AND BODY!
 12- IF YOUR WEAPON IS NOT FIRED WHEN THE TRIGGER HAS BEEN PICKED,
 HANDL YOUR WEAPON VERY CAREFULLY!: If the rifle is not fired when you
 pull the trigger, STOP first!. Do not forget to point your rifle in a safe direction!
 Keeping your face away from the area where the empty cartridge will come
 out, after turning off the safety, carefully open the mechanism and safely
 unload the rifle and get rid of the unexploded cartridge. Always act as if the
 rifle is loaded.
- 13- WHEN LOADING OR UNLOADING YOUR WEAPON, EVEN IF THE SAFETY BUTTON IS OFF (GREEN) ACT AS IF YOUR GUN IS LOADED!: The rifle is a mechanical tool, so wear and tear can occur over time. Always keep your finger away from the trigger while loading and unloading the rifle. In case of malfunction of the safety system of your rifle for any reason, the rifle may start unintentionally. In such a case, immediately unload your rifle and do not use it!
- 14- ALWAYS KEEP YOUR WEAPON WITH THE MECHANICAL AND STRUCTURAL SHAPE IT WAS BUYING!

* 1 FULL		Like duck and goose long distance hunts, long ranged rounds with shots inside	1-2-3	50 - 60 Meter
** 2 IMPROVED MODIFIED		Partridge, rabbit and pheasant 35-40 meters away in hunting, long ranged rounds with shots inside	4-5-6	35 - 40 Meter
*** 3 MODIFIED		Woodcock, pheasant and like a quail 30-35 meters distance hunts, with steel shots	5-6-7-8	30 - 35 Meter
**** 4 IMPROVED CYLINDER		For sporting purposes plate and skeet shot, short range distance	7-8-9-10 11-12	25 - 30 Meter
**** 5 SKEET		Like duck and goose long distance hunts, long ranged rounds with shots inside	7-8-9-10 11-12	20 - 25 Meter





- 1) Point your rifle in a safe direction. Remember that the "safe direction" means the direction in which no one will be harmed if your rifle accidentally fires.
- 2) Take your fingers away from the trigger.
- 3) Pull the cocking handle until all the cartridges in the chamber are discharged.
- 4) Lock the charging handle back using the mechanism locker and make sure there are no cartridges in the chamber.

BARREL FLASH HIDER WARNING:

NEVER IGNORE SAFETY RULES OR DON'T REMOVE FLASH HIDER WHEN THE GUN IS LOADED. WHILE THE GUN IS LOADED. MAKE SURE THE FLASH HIDERS ARE FITTED FULLY AND TIGHTLY ON THE BARREL. DO NOT FIRE. OTHERWISE THE BARREL WILL DAMAGE.

Disassembly





Remove magazine cap by moving it anti clockwise.




Pull barrel forward a bit and then remove forend by pressing it downward.




Remove barrel.




Now take out charging handle, move anti clockwise and take out..



Take out bolt.



Now remove receiver pin.



First pull trigger assembly backward and then take out.

Your gun is ready for general cleaning after these operations. If you want to clean the mechanism and gas system of your gun, you should follow the next steps.

NOTE: As a company, we do not recommend that users who do not have sufficient knowledge and experience disassemble the gas system.




Disassembly





Remove Evacuation valve cover by moving it anti clockwise.

Take out gas chamber piston by pulling forward.





Remove pins as shown in the picture.

Now remove firing pin.






Remove bolt head pin.

Finally remove bolt head.

Cleaning has been completed. Follow the next steps to assemble the shotgun.

insert locking head pin.




Insert firing pin.




After placing firing pin at its place, put Firing Pin Retaining Pin and other pins correctly.




Trigger assembly.




Place trigger assemebly, make sure that hammer is pressed back.

Now put gas chamber piston.




Place correctly Evacuation valve cover as shown in picture.











Place barrel correctly.




Place barrel and forend on theri places as shown in picture.




Hunt Group HG4 Trigger assembly Diagram




